Transnational Ireland, in conjunction with Maynooth University's Migration, Transnationalism and Diaspora research cluster, will hold a one day networking and knowledge exchange symposium at Maynooth University on Monday 12 September 2016. Focusing on the idea of 'transnationalism in practice', the event will comprise a transnational teaching roundtable, an emerging scholarship colloquium and a public lecture, to be delivered by Professor Alan Lester of the University of Sussex.
